<u>Elementary Camp (Weeks 1-4)</u>: Rising first through sixth years spend time in a Montessori Classroom exploring the following themes. Children must bring a **lunch*** each day.

- Week 1: Wizards and Wonders with Ms. Mulhall. Perfect for the Harry Potter enthusiast you know! Make potions, cast spells, discover enchanted creatures, learn magic, enjoy tournaments and play some guidditch. Come be a part of our magical world!
- Week 2: Mythology and Legends with Ms. Mulhall. Explore the characters and creatures of
 ancient Greek, Roman, and Norse civilizations! Discover lost artifacts, learn about the gods'
 special tools, make foods and play games fit for the gods! We will enact characters and
 create our own civilization and hold our own Olympics! Come explore with us!
- Week 3: Feel the STEAM with Ms. Carter-Nanian. Spend a day each exploring Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math with exciting projects and lessons from a Montessori Perspective!
- Week 4: Explore Biomes with Ms. Carter-Nanian. Explore the different biomes of the earth, as
 well as the fascinating plants, animals, cultures, and peoples that can be found in each of
 them!

<u>Primary Camp (Weeks 1-4)</u>: Campers will enjoy days comprised of circle time, outdoor play, arts and crafts, and time with Montessori Materials as they explore each week's theme:

- Week 1: Delve into the Arts with Miss Rucker. Give your creative side a time to shine as we explore arts and artists through lessons, stories, and arts and crafts projects!
- Week 2: Under the Sea with Ms. Nelson. Learn about our oceans and the many plants and creatures that make their homes in the sea!
- Week 3: The World of Dinosaurs with Ms. Nelson. Learn about the captivating creatures that lived on our planet long ago, as well as the fossils that they left behind!
- Week 4: Around the World with Ms. Kiess. Learn about maps, geography, and the exciting continents and cultures of the world!

Extended Day (Weeks 1-4):

For children whose camps end at 12:00, but want or need to stay until 3:30. Children will eat **lunch***, have a rest period where they may nap, read, or do other quiet activities.

Spanish Camp (Week 1):

Explore Spanish cultures, music, and language basics with Mrs. Curran including colors, shapes, animals, foods, and school materials! On Friday we will have joint water day with the Primary Camp group so bring bathing suits, towels and a change of clothes to enjoy some wet outdoor fun!

Mandarin Camp (Week 4):

Explore Chinese culture, music, and language basics with Mrs. Lu including greetings, animals, colors, anatomy, foods, and school materials! On Friday we will have joint water day with the Primary Camp group so bring bathing suits, towels and a change of clothes to enjoy some wet outdoor fun!

Lunch* Each child must bring their own lunch. We are a nut free school which means children may not bring any products that contain or have been in contact with peanuts/tree nuts. Products that say 'processed in a facility that processes/may process peanuts or tree nuts' cannot be brought. We also request that lunches be candy free.



Cancellation and refund policy

- The Montessori School of McLean reserves the right to cancel or combine any program due to insufficient enrollment. A full refund will be granted if a class is cancelled. Deposits are non-refundable, and are applied towards the camp tuition.
- All tuitions are due no later than May 18. Refunds minus the class deposits will be granted for withdrawals submitted before June 8. Refunds are not granted for withdrawals after June 8.
- There are no refunds for absences; as there are no provisions for make-up classes. There are no refunds for change of summer plans, transfer from the area, prolonged illness, or any other reason. No refund will be granted in the event of dismissal for inappropriate or unsafe conduct.

Deposit and Payment

A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$50 **per week, per child** must accompany the registration form. The deposit amount is deducted from the total tuition due. Full payment is due no later than May 18, 2018. You will be invoiced for any balance you owe by May 4. If final payment is not received by May 18, the space may be forfeited and given to the next student on the waiting list. If you register after May 18, full payment is due at time of registration. A fee of \$35 will be charged for any check that is not honored by your bank.

Necessary forms (current MSM students should have all forms here)

- Health Form All campers must have a VA state health form, signed and dated by a Doctor within the past 2 years of the dates your child will attend camp. In accordance with Virginia law, no child will be permitted in camp unless a current health form is on file.
- Emergency form This form is used in case of an emergency and taken on any field trips your child participates in. This form is mandatory, no camper will be allowed to enter camp without this being current and complete.
- Proof of identity required for all new or non MSM student campers. Per state law, one of the following original documents must be presented and copied here in our office:
 - Original birth certificate
 - Passport
 - Birth registration card of record
 - o Report card from a public school in VA
- M.A.T. (Medical Administration Training) forms if your child has any life threatening allergies either to
 food and/or insects we must have the necessary paperwork and medications here in the office.
 These forms must have been signed by a physician within the past 6 months of when your child will
 be attending camp. Please contact the office if you need these forms.

Sunscreen

It is MSM's policy <u>not</u> to apply sunscreen to your child. Your child will be going outside each day at least once. If you want sunscreen on your child, you must apply it in the morning before they come to camp or you may come to camp and apply it during the day. Most primary camps will have water day and/or a field trip, once a week. The particular day will be communicated to you at the beginning of each week. Elementary children will also be going outside, please apply their sunscreen in the morning. Children may NOT carry sunscreen in their backpacks to apply themselves.
